All information on this application will be kept secure by New Life Corrections Ministry and only be given to IDOC for security approval. Your name and address will be used to send you updates on the activities of New Life Corrections Ministry.

Going into an Illinois Department of Corrections (IDOC) facility under this arrangement (receiving a Gate Pass to volunteer under the direction of a Volunteer Chaplain ) will limit your IDOC involvement to once per quarter (three months). If you desire to be involved more often than once per quarter, you must complete a full IDOC volunteer application (11 pages, takes many months for approval). You can obtain an IDOC application from Chaplain Tom.

**Please remember! To be a volunteer Literature Distributor, you must bring literature with you! I will supply tracts, Bible teaching brochures, & Bible Lessons (all specially designed for inmates). I suggest you bring at least 75 books & magazines – *CHRISTIAN MATERIAL PREFERRED* – 3/4" thick maximum (to slip under door), paperbacks only, staples OK, novels, teachings, biographies (missionary biographies are the best!), wholesome reading, magazines (with address labels removed, please not more than 3-4 months old), & current devotionals. Come prayerfully!**
